Dear Parent,

You can help your child develop skills that are needed for reading. Read each activity to your child. As you work together, make each activity gamelike and fun.

1. Practice writing these letters: **V v W w X x**
Say each letter as you write it.

2. Let's play a rhyme game! Listen to some words I say. Tell me if they rhyme: *dog-fog, tent-top, pig-wig.*
3. Pretend we're at the zoo. What animals do we see? What sounds do the animals make? Let's take turns making different animal sounds and guessing the names of the animals that make the sounds. (Take turns making animal sounds and identifying the animals that make the sounds: lion, duck, seal, monkey.)
4. Draw a picture of your favorite zoo animal.
